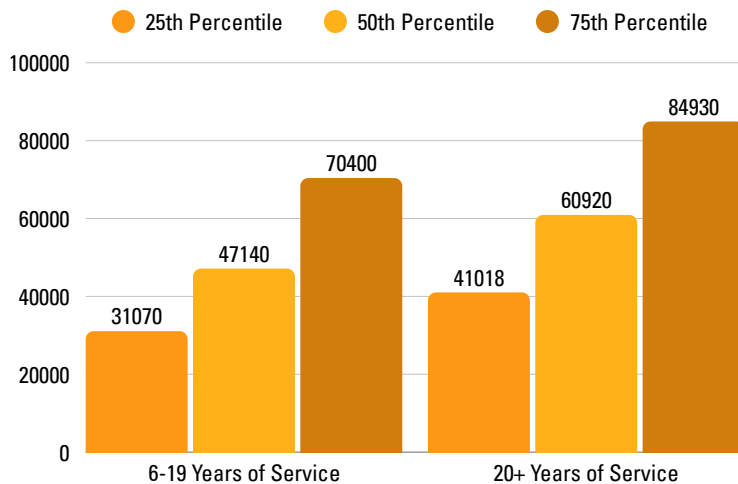


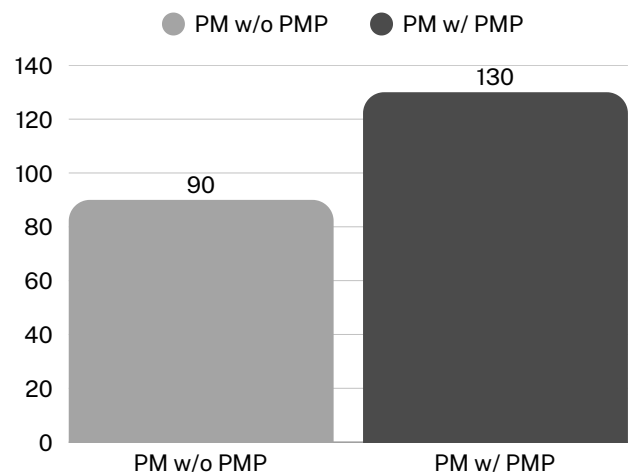


Average Veteran Salary vs. Salary Impact of a PMP

So to Recap:

- Average Veteran Salary 1 Year Post Discharge: **~\$60,000**
- Average Salary of a Certified PMP: **~\$130,000**
- Difference: **~\$70,000**

Even if you are in the 75th percentile making \$85k a year, if you invest it in yourself, you could **gain \$45k** per year.
